

5 Car Detailing Tips & Tricks

Washing your car is the single most important thing you can do to ensure your vehicle continually looks its best. However not every wash is created equal. A gentle and effective hand wash will reduce scratches over time and ensure the paint stays vibrant.

Wheel cleaning can be a chore and is often the dirtiest part of the wash process. Spray your wheel cleaner on a cool dry wheel and let it to dwell for 60 seconds. This will allow the cleaner to react with the brake dust making the cleaner more effective.

When cleaning wheels, our secret tool that we turn to often isn't a brush but a wash mitt. This mitt conforms to intricate areas to make cleaning far easier.

If you currently have wax or sealant protection on your car, always think about what kind of soap you're using to clean your paint. A pH balanced soap will not break down your protection but instead only clean the surface. This will prolong your wax/sealant.

While washing or drying your car, lubrication is incredibly important in reducing scratching. During the wash, your soap is the lubrication between the paint and wash mitt. While drying, use a quick detailer as the lubricant between the paint and your microfiber towel. The whole thought process is, you want to use these lubricates to safely pickup dirt without letting it dig into the paint, causing scratches.
